Our vineyard parcels in these Lands of Volcanoes express the essence of their origin. Cold winds and wide thermal amplitudes make our identity.

This wine has an intense ruby red color with violet hues. On the nose it offers complex aromas, reminiscent of cassis, raspberries, interlaced with sweet spices such as black pepper and cloves. Intense and full-bodied, this remarkably elegant wine has a smooth texture and excellent balance. Its acidity and medium tannins give it a long and persistent finish.
